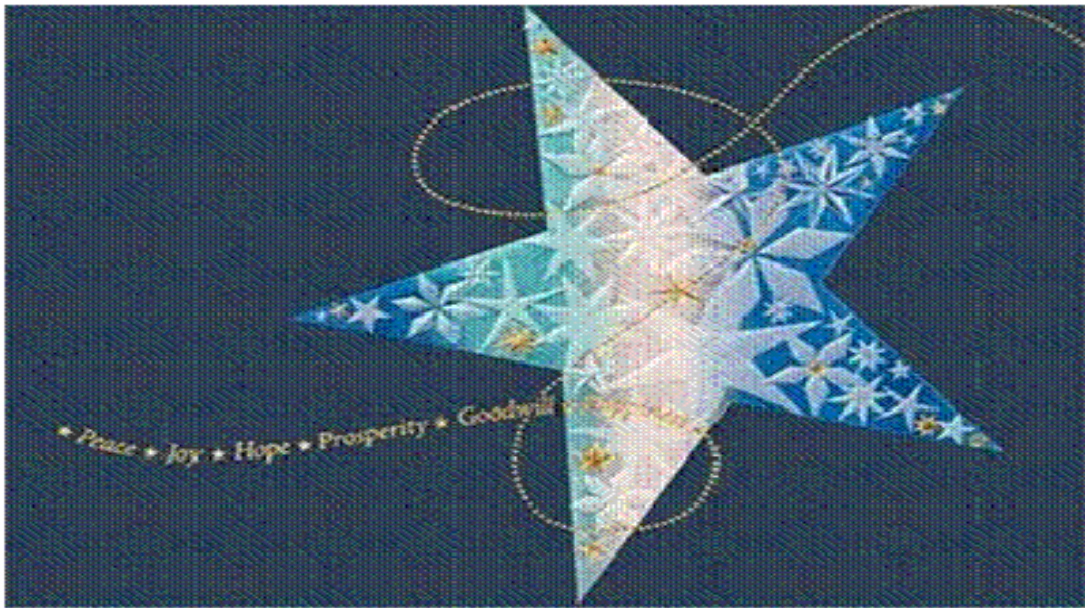

## ELUPEG Autumn Meeting – November 23<sup>rd</sup> in Brussels hosted by P&G

The 31st ELUPEG Group Meeting was held in Brussels kindly hosted by P&G on November 23rd in their auditorium after an excellent networking meal the previous night in a local Belgian restaurant. The meeting was attended by over 30 delegates and was kicked off with an excellent presentation from Sergio Barbarino, P&G, on Collaboration Concept for Co-modality CO3 which is an exciting new project funded by EU to produce operational model frameworks for collaborative projects in the Supply Chain with 18 participants and a High Level Industry Board which includes members of our Steering Board

This was followed by 'Logistics and Transport Vision 2035' presented by Jolyon Drury, Public Policies Committee ILT—The speed of change and sense of urgency will drive the evolution of the value chain over the next decade. Are we ready?

To keep with the futuristic theme our Vice Chairman Brian Bolam presented ELUPEG Vision 20/20 . This involves 2 projects currently

- ⇒ **TAILgate- A "Multimodal Discovery Portal" designed to deliver "least cost & lowest Carbon Footprint Transportation Solutions in close to real time"**
- ⇒ **Transnet Euro- A Proposed European Infrastructure Project based on Mega-Truck-stops at the Eleven Key Nodes of Freight Intersection across Europe in order to facilitate 24X7X365 primary movements & deliver a quantum reduction in Supply Chain Costs**



To conclude the morning session Andreas Mühlböck from LKW WALTER talked about how carriers address reductions in CO2 and Felip Degroote, Stanley Black & Decker, talked about Multimodal Transportation experiences within his company—all interspersed with questions and comments

The group broke into 3 smaller interactive sessions in the afternoon to discuss 3 'hot topics' that Brian had prepared in advance and then returned to share their feedback with everyone.
